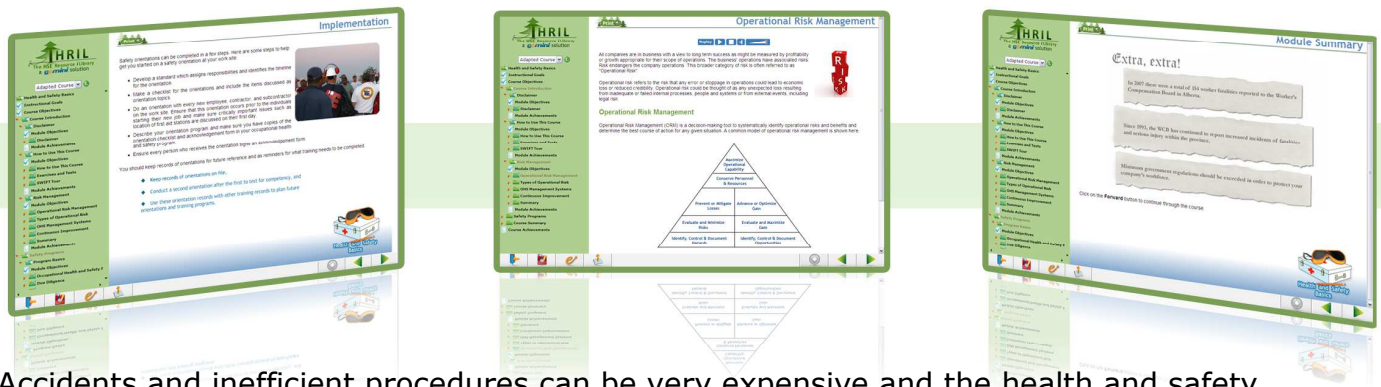


Health and Safety Program Basics
